



### PARKING IN PARADISE

Historically known as the "People's Beach", Tybee Island continues to welcome visitors to the nostalgic island which many call home and where business thrives year-round. Tybee is a "Pay-to-Park Community" in order to keep critical island services available for visitors and residents. Parking regulations are enforced 8AM - 8PM, 365 days a year. Public parking areas have either parking meters or pay-and-display tickets, with fees of either \$1.50 or \$2.00 per hour, depending on the proximity to the beaches.

Main parking areas are available in the following locations: South Beach Parking Lot, located beachside between 14th and 28th Streets; North Beach Parking Lot, located beachside immediately across from the Tybee Island Lighthouse; beachside streets adjacent to Butler Avenue, and along the Main Business Corridor.
